

How to use the Hadfield Flipbook

For this activity, you will need:

- Print-outs of the Hadfield pages
- Rubber bands, binder clip, tape or glue- to bind the edge of your flip book
- Scissors

Step 1:

Using your scissors, cut out each frame. Make sure to leave a border on the left side of the frame for the binding.

Step 2:

Stack all of your frames in order, and tap your pages down to the right side of the book so all of the pages are aligned.

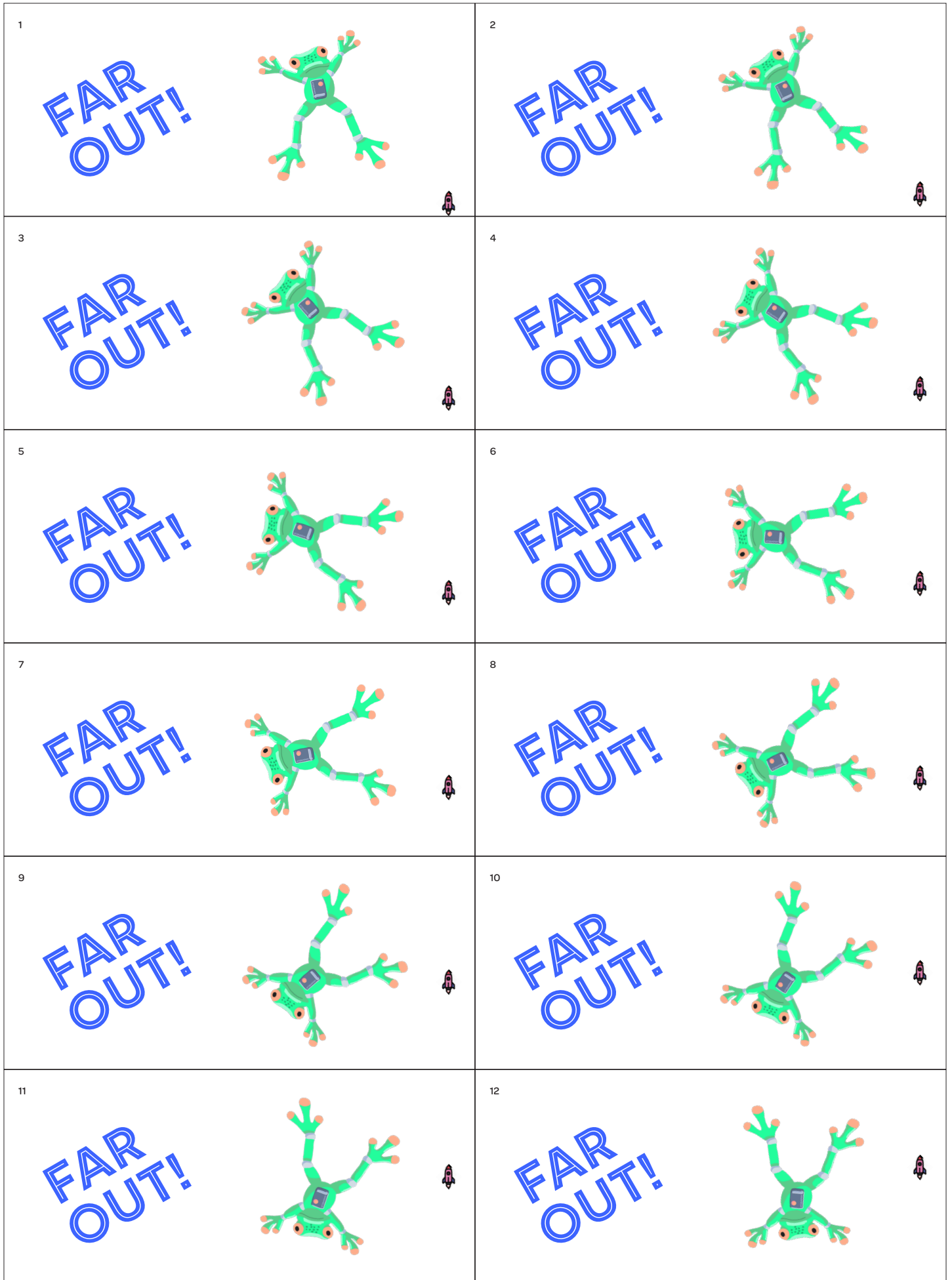










With your pages all assembled together, it's time to bind your book. You can use a binder clip, rubber bands or glue, too. See what you have and investigate which materials work best to bind your book.
